Guidelines and Code of Healer Ethics for Sri Kaleshwar Healers

Ethics for Sai Shakti Healers

Know and abide by all relevant laws and regulations in your area governing alternative, spiritual and/or complementary healing.

If you have a healing license in a different healing modality, be aware of and follow any requirements of that licensure which may govern use of other modalities. As well, be clear with your clients as to when you are operating under that license and when you are performing as a Sai Shakti Healer.

Before a session and at the time of setting an appointment, provide an oral or written statement that details:

- What happens during a session, including a description of touch that may occur;
- What to expect after a session;
- Approximate time the healing session will require;
- That this is not a medical or psychological treatment and is alternative and spiritual, which may compliment other treatments you are receiving;
- Your charge or charging system and payment options; Your confidentiality, cancellation, attendance, emergency, rescheduling, termination, and refusal of service policies.
- Your inability to guarantee or predict a specific outcome due to the nature of soul healing.

In addition to clear information for the client about the healing session, please remember to uphold the professionalism and integrity of Sai Shakti Healing by doing the following:

- ❖ Abide by a vow of confidentiality. Any information that is discussed within the context of a session is confidential between the client and practitioner.
- ❖ If you take notes -- Maintain confidentiality of these notes unless a release of this information is authorized in writing by the patient or otherwise required by law.
- ❖ Do not offer a medical or psychological diagnosis or cure or make any recommendation to discontinue or alter current or suggested medical or psychological treatment prescribed by a licensed healthcare practitioner;
- ❖ Provide a safe and comfortable area for healing sessions and provide an empowering and supportive environment for clients.
- ❖ Always treat clients with the utmost respect and honor.
- ❖ Do not have any sexual contact with a current or former client.
- ❖ Do not touch, behave or speak in any way that could be considered demeaning, attacking or sexual.
- ❖ Ask permission when touching the client, and comply if they refuse touch. Be extra careful when touching by explaining where and how you will touch. Do not touch the genital area or breasts. Practice hands-off healing of these areas if treatment is needed.
- ❖ Never ask clients to disrobe and never reach inside their clothing to touch on chakras.
- ❖ Be sensitive to the boundary and other special needs of clients. Ask about their sensitivities (especially with respect to touch, energy transmission, and healing crisis).
- ❖ Have a pure and clear intention to offer your services for the highest healing good of the client.
- ❖ Be clear about the Source of Sai Shakti Healing (Divine Source and Lineage of Swami, Baba, Jesus, etc.) while being respectful of all paths and beliefs.
- ❖ Educate clients on the background of the energy, mantras, yantras, holy objects, and lotus

petals that you are using.

- ❖ Be sure to do and prescribe the mantras as Sri Kaleshwar dictated and follow all dikshas. (“No Masala” means: do not mix up mantras, make up diksha or mantras, or get mantra processes confused with other processes from other traditions).
- ❖ Suggest a consultation or referral for clients to qualified licensed professionals (medical doctor, licensed therapist, nutritionist etc.) when appropriate.
- ❖ Work to create harmony and friendly cooperation between Kaleshwar Practitioners and Teachers and between Kaleshwar Practitioners and your community.
- ❖ Do not speak ill of other practitioners or engage in gossip about others with a client.
- ❖ Act as a beacon in your community by doing the best job possible, honoring commitments and doing local seva.
- ❖ Work to empower clients to heal themselves.
- ❖ Be actively engaged in your own sadhana and continue to purify yourself so you can be the clearest instrument of the Divine.
